

REGISTERING

In order to process your registration, we need you to bring in the following documents:

- Purple NHS Registration Form GMS1.
- Crawley Down Health Centre Patient Questionnaire.
- Photo identification such as a passport or driving licence.
- Proof of your address: This can be a letter such as a formal lease document, tax statement or utility bill. Bank statements will only be accepted as a last resort and will need to show a pattern of spending in the UK.
- If you have arrived from another country, we need to see your passport and valid visa or work permit if applicable.
- Complete the request for on-line service form.

To complete your registration you will need to have a new patient check, at which time you will need to provide a fresh urine sample. You can collect a specimen bottle from Reception and hand in a fresh urine sample any day before 12 noon (or bring it with you at your new patient check appointment).

ONLINE SERVICES – EMIS ACCESS

You can book, cancel appointments, order repeat prescriptions and access your medical records, (provided you are over the age of 16) using the online services. Complete the forms at reception or on-line and you will be given your unique passcode.

RESULTS OF TESTS AND X-RAYS

Please call 01342 713031 between 2.00 – 4.00pm on for results. Routine blood tests, urine and swab results usually take about four days, X-ray results seven to ten working days.

We have a dispensary service available for patients located more distant from the practice.

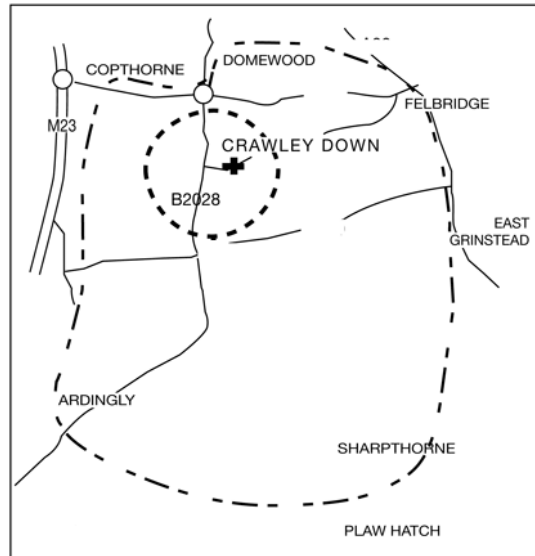

Crawley Down Health Centre Opening Times

From 8.00am - 6.30pm, Monday to Friday.

If you have an **urgent** problem please telephone between 8.30a.m and 10.30a.m. on the day. Urgent cases will be seen by whichever doctor is available.

Routine appointments can only be pre booked up to six weeks in advance.

REPEAT PRESCRIPTIONS

All repeat prescription requests must be made in writing to the Practice.

We have post boxes at Costcutters in Sharpthorne, and Central stores in Turners Hill for our patients living in more rural areas.

2 to 3 full working days, excluding weekends and bank holidays, are normally required between receipt of the request and the prescription being available.

We do not accept prescription requests by telephone unless previously authorised by the Doctor.
